Job Title: Preschool Teacher

Reports To: Preschool Director

Classification: Part-Time

Job Description

The purpose of the Preschool Teacher position is to provide and maintain a Christian environment in which the child may grow physically, emotionally, mentally, socially, and spiritually. The Preschool Teacher, with teaching partner, will be responsible for preparation and implementation of the curriculum, classroom, materials, planning time and reasonable clean-up of the classroom and materials. The Preschool Teacher will use California Preschool Learning Foundations and Guidelines and use the DRDP for student assessments.

Primary Responsibilities

This is a working list and may be adjusted at any time by the supervisor

- Provide and maintain a Christian environment in which the child may grow physically, emotionally, mentally, socially, and spiritually.
- Ensure the children's safety within the inside and outside environments at all times.
- Work with teaching partner in preparation and implementation of curriculum, classroom, materials, and planning time.
- Direct all issues to the suitable person in a timely and appropriate manner.
- Observe and respond to children's needs, emergencies, and/or conflicts that might occur during the day.

Relationships

This position will report directly to the Preschool Director and work alongside other staff.

Qualifications and Gifts

Preschool Teacher needs to agree with Ventura Missionary Church's Statement of Faith and agree to employment subject to and conditioned upon a lifestyle consistent with that Statement of Faith. This position must have a philosophy of ministry that is aligned with Scripture, with our Statement of Faith, and with our Core Values and Vision. Gifts that are consistent with this role are: Leadership, Organization, Pastoring, and Encouragement

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Love for God and His church
- Possess a deep, abiding relationship with God
- Problem-solving and conflict resolution techniques

- Operate in a team environment, often working cross-functionally with other teams
- Able to adjust to the pace of the job requirements
- Includes standing or walking most of the time, with bending, stooping, squatting, twisting, and reaching; includes occasionally lifting objects weighing over 25 pounds

Minimum Job Qualifications

- Minimum of twelve (12) units in Early Childhood Education
- Successful completion of fingerprinting process and criminal background clearance
- TB clearance, immunizations and Health Screening
